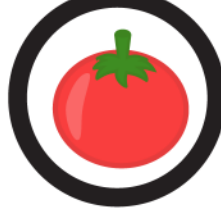
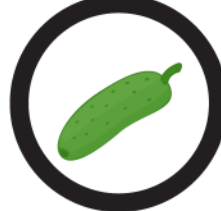
These yellow flowers will produce a fruit that tastes delicious on pizza and as a sauce on pasta.



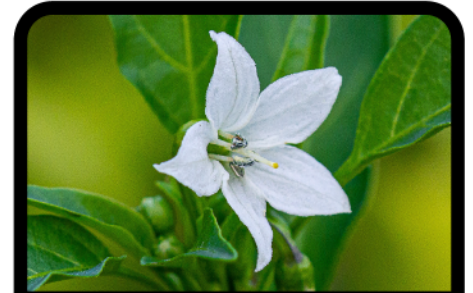
This flower will produce a fruit with purple skin and a soft white fleshy inside.



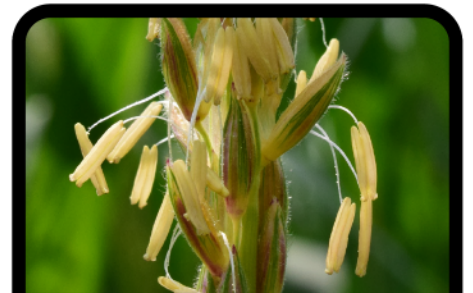
This white flower grows on a plant that likes to climb. The fruit it produces is a tasty pod.
